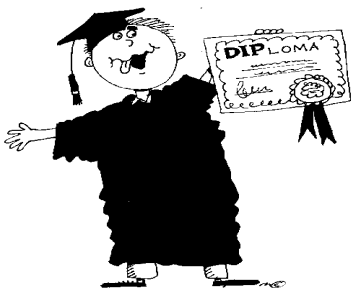

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR (Kg, 2, 6)

Incoming kindergarten students need to obtain a complete physical from a doctor's office, a vision exam (anytime after Oct. 15, 2009), and a dental exam (anytime after Nov. 15, 2009). Dental exams are not due until May 15, 2011. However, it is never too early to turn them in. Students entering second grade are required to have a dental exam. Students entering sixth grade are required to have both a full physical and a dental exam.

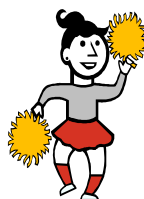
Lawrence Carie is retiring from the position as Athletic Director at the end of this school year. We are having a reception for him immediately following the Athletic Awards.

CHEERLEADING SPONSOR

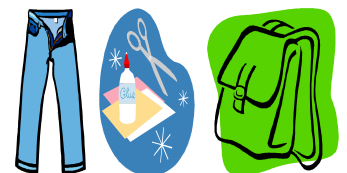

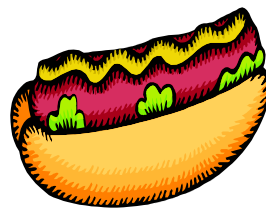
DO YOU NEED TO ATTEND PROTECTING GODS CHILDREN?
