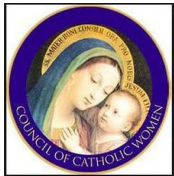

You're invited to enroll in the Brown Scapular: An Opportunity for Committing to a Life of Prayer and Following Christ Daily

The brown scapular is made of cloth and is worn over the shoulders by cloth or a cord. It can also be a medal on a chain in some cases. It is a gift from Our Blessed Mother and represents a life of prayer and is a sign of your commitment to follow Christ daily. There have been many miracles connected with the brown scapular.



The Church extends this extraordinary privilege to all the laity who wear the scapular and are willing to be invested in the Brown Scapular of the Carmelites. To be eligible for the promise Our Blessed Mother gave to St. Simon Stock, that whoever dies wearing the brown scapular will not burn in eternal fire, one must be enrolled in the Family of Carmel which can be done by a priest. They then wear the Brown Scapular to indicate that they place themselves under the special protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

The feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel is July 16. This year, July 16 falls on a Saturday, so we will be having an 8:30am Mass on Saturday, July 16, in honor of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. Immediately after the Mass, there will be an Investiture of the Brown Scapular ceremony for anyone wishing to be enrolled in the Brown Scapular. The scapulars will be provided.

School Uniforms & Discounts

As we head into July, we want to share important information about school uniforms so you can get a head start getting ready for school to start in August.

- ♣ At this time, we are continuing our uniform business with Jedco Sales in Effingham. Uniforms with our previous school logo are still approved to wear.
- ♣ In order to maintain consistency and professionalism with our dress code, we want to confirm some important details about our school uniform policy:
 - The Sacred Heart School uniform collection (including the approved Monday-Thursday polo shirts, pullovers, and jumpers/dresses) may only be purchased at Jedco. We have specific garments and colors selected and only those items may be worn to school on regular dress code days. This ensures that the approved colors, designs, and styles are used and protects the uniformity and authenticity of our dress code.
 - Any green/shamrock apparel purchased at vendors other than Jedco can be worn on Fridays only. These will be considered 'spirit wear' and are not part of our Monday-Thursday uniform.
- ♣ Orders can be placed anytime online (<https://sacredheartschooluniform.itemorder.com/>) or in the store at 2313 Hoffman Drive, Effingham.

Back to School Reminders:

As we prepare for school starting in August, please make sure to have all health exams completed. All medical forms (physical, dental, and/or vision forms (for applicable grades) and all required paperwork should be turned in to the school office by the first day of school on August 17. Kindergarten: full physical, updated immunizations, dental exam, vision screening

Grade 2: dental exam

Students participating in sports must complete a sports physical and have an updated signed concussion form on file in the school office.

Beginning-of-the-year payments are due with your August tuition payment on August 1. Each of these payments needs to be on separate checks. These payments include:

- ♣ **Two weeks of lunches per child**, which is either \$28 or \$32.50
 - Grade K-5 lunches = \$2.80/day
 - Grades 6-8 have option of a regular tray (\$2.80/day) or a tray with side salad (\$3.25/day)
 - (Check payable to Sacred Heart Hot Lunch Program)
- ♣ **\$20 Booster Club fee per family** (Check payable to Sacred Heart Booster Club)
- ♣ **\$20 PTA fee per family** (Check payable to Sacred Heart PTA)
