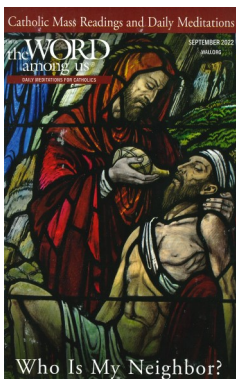
Message from Fr. Michal...

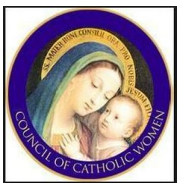

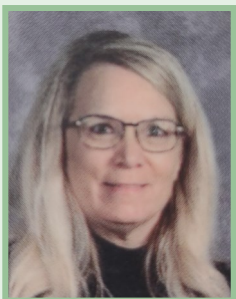

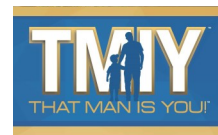
