PLENARY INDULGENCES

From November 1-8, you will have the opportunity to get plenary indulgences.

To receive a plenary indulgence, you need to first go to confession, then each day during this time period you are required to say prayers, receive communion, be free of venial sin, and make a visit to the cemetery Nov. 1-8. Fr. Michal will be going after the 8:30am daily Masses to the cemetery. He will also go after the 4:00pm Saturday evening Mass and the 8:30am Sunday Mass (Nov. 6-7). Please join him each day.

An indulgence is defined as "the remission before God of the temporal punishment due for sins already forgiven as far as their guilt is concerned." The first thing to note is that forgiveness of a sin is separate from punishment for the sin. Through sacramental confession we obtain forgiveness, but we aren't let off the hook as far as punishment goes. Indulgences are two kinds: partial and plenary. A partial indulgence removes part of the temporal punishment due for sins. A plenary indulgence removes all of it. A plenary indulgence is the remission, through the merits of Christ and the saints, through the Church, of all temporal punishment due to sin already forgiven. This punishment may come either in this life, in the form of various sufferings, or in the next life, in purgatory. What we don't get rid of here, we suffer there.



Monday, November 1, is All Saints Day. On this day, we recall the holy men and women who, having completed their earthly journeys, now live forever with God. As a solemnity, Masses will be celebrated at 8:30am and 7:00pm. Please note, a server's meeting will still be at 6:15pm on Monday, Nov. 1; however, Adoration & Reconciliation will be moved to Monday, Nov. 8, at 7:00pm.

Tuesday, November 2, is All Soul's Day, the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed. Masses will be celebrated at 8:30am, 12:10pm, and 7:00pm. The 7:00pm Mass will be for all Sacred Heart parishioners who died this past year. We will once again have the Jacob's Ladder and the Book of Remembrance in the church. If you have a picture of a family member who died this year, we encourage you to place it on the ladder on All Souls Day, Nov. 2, where we all can keep the memory of your loved one alive in prayer.

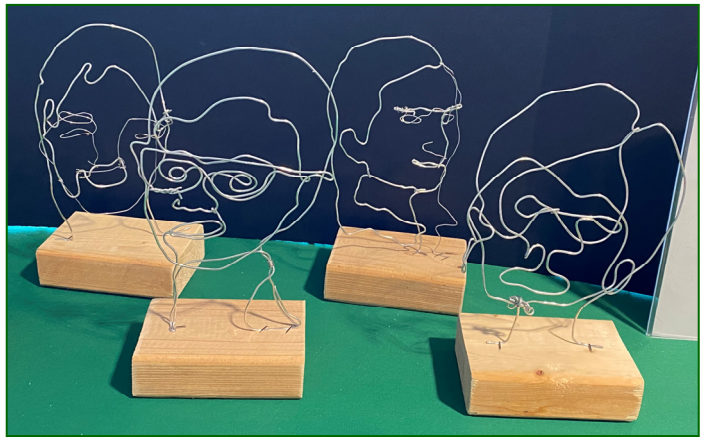
