are able to open up the church more. All changes are effective this weekend, June 19 & 20, unless otherwise noted.

- Masks will not be required for any of the ministries. You are welcome to wear a mask if you feel more comfortable with it, but it is not required.
- Lectors: Lectors will now carry the Gospel book and process in with Fr. Michal before and after Mass. Starting in July there will be two Lectors scheduled for weekend Masses.
- Gift Bearers: Gift Bearers will now be scheduled for weekend Masses.
- Ushers:
 - •Begin using handled baskets for collection
 - Process with Gift Bearers to bring up collection
 - Leave one basket in the narthex, remove all others
 No longer need to release/dismiss pews for Communion
 - •At the end of Mass, bring collection money to the sacristy
- Eucharistic Ministers of Holy Communion: No changes at this time we are still using one EMHC and will follow the same distribution that we have been.
- **Sacristans**: Sacristans will now need to prepare the bread and wine for the Gift Bearers. They will also place the Gospel book in the back of church for the procession.
- Servers: Servers will now come forward to help Fr. Michal receive the gifts. There may be other changes as well, which Fr. Michal will instruct as needed.

As always, we appreciate your patience and flexibility as we make adjustments and changes. We are excited to be getting people more involved with ministries again and engaging the entire church family.
