This weekend we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. Pope St. John Paul II named this feast 'Divine Mercy Sunday' due to a series of revelations to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s.

Divine Mercy Sunday completes our Easter Octave. The miracle of Easter does not end on Easter Sunday! It is celebrated each and every day—but especially during the Easter Octave which represents God's perfect completion in our lives and the eternity He offers us through His grace and mercy. The Easter Octave represents our journey to Heaven through the course of our lives. It starts on Easter Sunday when Jesus rose from the dead and opened the gates of Heaven. The next seven days are symbolic of our lives—our pilgrimage on earth, looking for Heaven. Once we get to the eighth day (Divine Mercy Sunday), we can enter into Eternity through the door Jesus opened on Easter.

In order to fully receive the mercies available on Divine Mercy Sunday, you should be free of sin (having recently been to Confession) and should pray the following prayer after receiving Communion:

Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the living God, have mercy on me, a poor sinner. Jesus, You promised St. Faustina that the soul who has been to confession (I have), and the soul that receives Holy Communion (I just did), will receive complete forgiveness of all sin and punishment. Please give me this grace.

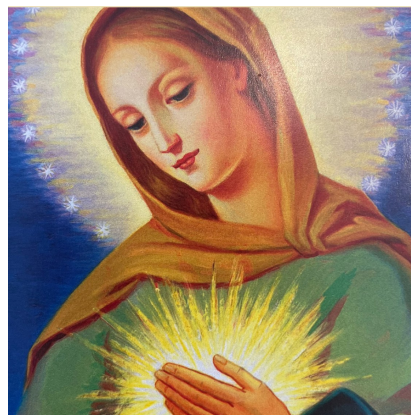

“Home Missions” is the name for dioceses and

parishes in the United States, including its territories and former territories, which cannot provide basic pastoral services to Catholics without outside help. Basic pastoral services include Mass and sacraments, religious education, and ministry training for priests, deacons, religious sisters and lay people. Generally speaking, the home missions are everywhere that Catholics are few and the Church is fragile.

An area close to Effingham that is helped by the Home Mission Appeal is East St. Louis/Belleville, IL. East St. Louis/Belleville is one of the poorest communities in our nation. The Sister Thea Bowman Catholic School (STBCS) provides the only alternative to the troubled public school system. The population of the STBCS elementary school is comprised of 99% racial minorities. In addition, 90% of the families fall below the poverty line and only 4% are Catholic. The children are often raised by someone other than their biological parents and know the realities of drugs, violence, and crime. Funding from Catholic Home Missions Appeal helps STBCS to continue providing the best holistic Catholic education possible for the children enrolled and is a vehicle for evangelization. Despite the challenges that the children at STBCS face, 100% of its graduates enter high school, and 95% of its graduates are enrolled in college or university.
