

It is simply Jesus Christ on the cross. With the simplicity of the painting, it allows us to truly focus on Jesus



and reflect on what He did for us. His death on the cross took away our sins and His resurrection opens the gates of Heaven for us. Take a moment to reflect on that truth and thank Him for His sacrifice.
