New Ministries

Please contact the parish office if you are interested in joining any of these new and exciting ministries!

Torchbearer Ministry: Torchbearers will carry our new torches during processions for special occasions a few times during the year. The next time we need torchbearers will be for Corpus Christi on June 2. Qualifications to be a torchbearer include: Minimum age of 16, able to kneel at the altar while holding a torch, and willing to wear a nice suit.

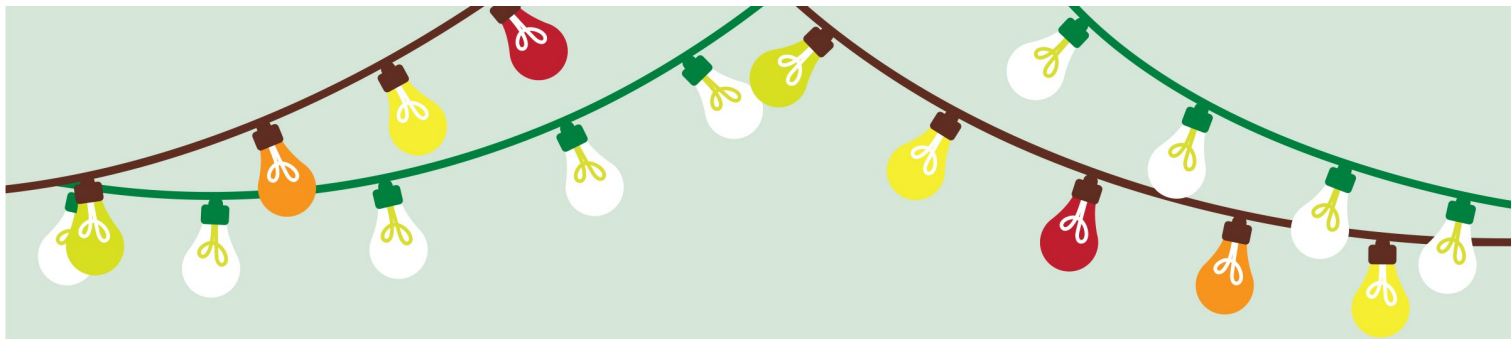
