Campaign Frequently Asked Questions

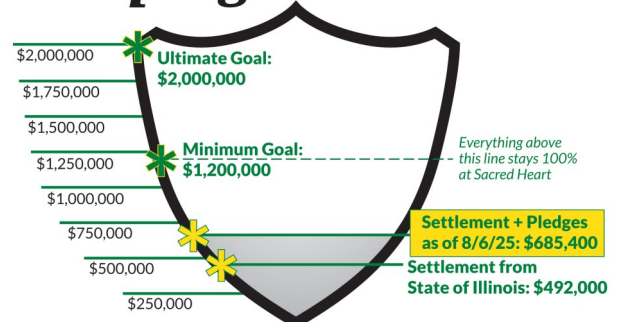
Can we go ahead and make a pledge or donation to the campaign now? Or, do we need to wait until someone contacts us?

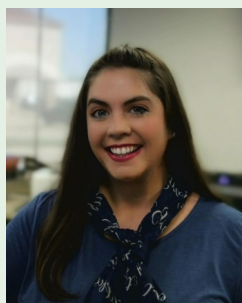
Ms. Kelsey Partlow, Fifth Grade

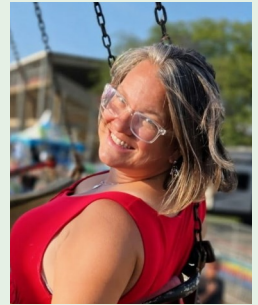
Mrs. Jennifer Estrada, Spanish
