

2020-21 Back to School Breakdown

- MASKS** Everyone (students, staff, visitors) will be required to wear a mask at all times while in the building. Masks will be worn 'from vehicle to vehicle', meaning the mask is on before entering the building and stays on until you are out of the building. A clean mask should be worn each day.
- TEMP CHECK** A temperature and symptom check will be completed each day on everyone entering the building. Parents dropping off their children cannot leave until their child(ren) is(are) cleared. Temperatures must be less than 100.4 degrees and there can be no visible illness symptoms.
- WATER BOTTLES** Students will need to bring their own water bottles and will have opportunities for refills throughout the day. There will be no direct drinking from water fountains.
- CLASS OUTSIDE** Weather permitting, we will have class outside as much as possible. Students will NOT need to wear masks outside.
- DESKS/ CUBBIES** Students' desks will be distanced in the classrooms. Their backpacks, jackets and all personal belongings will be kept at their desks, or in cubbies spaced out from each other.
- TEACHERS** Unless absolutely necessary, teachers will not teach or interact with classes other than their own. The exceptions to this include art, music, band, resource and Title I, as well as junior high where the teachers will teach the subject they specialize in (math, science, English).
- LIBRARY** Students will not visit the school library, instead, the librarian will bring a crate of books to each classroom. After returned, the books will sit untouched for 3 days before being handled.
- BAND & MUSIC** Band and music will have class outside as much as the weather permits. Unfortunately, we will not have a marching band this fall.
- OUTSIDE AREAS** Each class will have a sectioned off area in the grass for recess. Any areas not roped off (playground, baseball field) will have a rotation schedule so each class gets a turn.
- DROP OFF & PICK UP** Morning drop off and afternoon pick up will look differently than normal. Classes will be distanced and will have designated areas. More details will be shared closer to school starting.
- BUSES** Unit 40 is working on a bus plan and will share it soon. If possible, we encourage parents to find alternative transportation to/from school in order to reduce the number of kids on the buses.
- SPORTS** As of right now, we do not know if we will have sports. We are waiting for an update from IESA.
- CLUBHOUSE** We will continue to offer Clubhouse. However, students in Clubhouse will stay in their individual classrooms. Different classes and grades will not intermix. Masks will be worn and the same distancing guidelines will be in place that are followed throughout the day.

This plan is subject to change at any time as we receive new guidelines and recommendations from the Illinois State Board of Education, Illinois Department Public Health, Effingham County Health Department, and the Springfield Diocese.

School News



Just a reminder that morning drop-off will be from 7:30am-8:00am. Please have students to school on time so they can unpack their backpacks and get organized to start their day.

We are limiting the amount of people coming in to the school building. Foot traffic will be reduced as much as possible and we will have a minimum amount of volunteers. If you need to drop off something for your child/grandchild, please go up and ring the school bell like normal. From there, follow instructions from Mrs. Harnish. She may ask you to use our new outdoor drop-off window. Masks are required at all times for everyone in the building. Temperatures will be checked for everyone coming in the building. Temporarily, guests (parents, grandparents, etc.) will not be able to join students for lunch.

Due to social distancing guidelines, our school Mass will be separated into multiple Masses instead of one large Mass. *Masses will be separated into grades as follows:*



- ♣ Monday – Grades 2 & 3
- ♣ Tuesday – Grades 1 & 8
- ♣ Wednesday – Grades K, 6, 7
- ♣ Thursday – Grades 4 & 5

- Students should follow the Mass-day dress code (*no jeans*) on their designated Mass day.
- Everyone will wear a mask while attending Mass. Grades 4-8 will slide their masks down to receive Communion. Grades K-3 will go up for a blessing and will keep their masks on the entire time.
- There will be one server assigned to each Mass. Servers are asked not to wear shorts.
- Parents/grandparents are welcome to join their children for Mass. There will be a designated seating area for families and guests. You must arrive before Mass begins.


