Campaign Frequently Asked Questions

Why are we spending money on a new fountain and campus entrances?

When IDOT purchased property for the Fayette Avenue expansion, the money we received was retribution for surrendered land, as well as for the structures we lost (i.e. the original fountain, entrance columns, etc). The \$492,000 settlement provided funds for us to build new structures to replace the old, and to establish welcoming entrances to our campus.

The old fountain was very nostalgic for our parishioners and community. With the high level of traffic and exposure on our north side, a new water feature will connect with the heritage from the past while providing an eyecatching and welcoming invitation for people to join us at Sacred Heart.

With the Fayette Avenue expansion changing the flow of traffic around our campus, our Raney Street and Henrietta Avenue entrances will gain more traffic than in the past. Adding signage at these entrances will make them more noticeable and provide a nice, clear greeting for passersby and guests. Additionally, adding the raised boulevard at the Raney Street entrance allows us to remove the yellow clearance bar that was previously above this entrance (meant to deter semi traffic). This clearance bar was unsightly and was knocked down numerous times by semis trying to drive under it. The new raised boulevard was intentionally designed to prevent semis from turning into the parking lot at that entrance.


