ST. MARGARET MARY ALACOQUE

Born in France in 1647, St. Margaret Mary's heart was set on the love of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament from a very young age. She was a sickly girl before being miraculously healed, and because of this healing, promised to enter religious life. She eventually entered the Visitation Convent at Paray-la-Monial.



She is known for having several private revelations of Jesus. She claimed that Jesus had chosen her to tell the world of His desire to make known to all mankind the wonders of His love. Margaret Mary even reported that Jesus permitted her to rest her head upon His heart, subsequently disclosing to her the wonders of His love. As with most extraordinary graces, her superiors, and even the Church, took their time in coming to believe in these miraculous conversations between Margaret Mary and Our Lord. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque is considered the saint who popularized the devotion to Jesus' Most Sacred Heart, even though this devotion goes back to the early centuries of the Catholic Church.

To have a second-class relic of hers in this house of prayer is very fitting, as our parish community is called "Sacred Heart." Jesus, who is fully God, yet born from the Virgin Mary, did not exempt Himself from the movements and dispositions of the human condition. This devotion flows from the very foundations of Christian teaching. Jesus ascended into heaven with His body. This means that He still loves us for eternity with a beating *human heart*.


