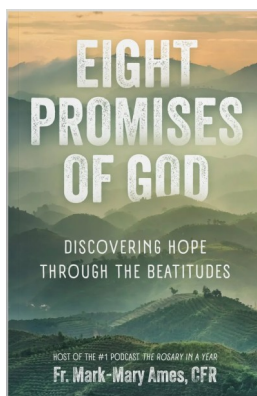

They are personal promises of goodness from God to his people. Through prayerful reflection, real-life stories, and the deep well of the Church's wisdom, Fr. Mark-Mary illuminates how these blessings of Christ are not abstract or out of reach. They are alive, present, and deeply relevant—especially in our moments of greatest need.
