

Sacrament Information

Sacrament of Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism initiates an individual into the Catholic Church. It brings new life by water and the Holy Spirit to free them from original sin. To begin the process, please set up an appointment to meet with Fr. Michal for a short baptismal session to discuss the Rite of Baptism. It helps to have this done prior to the birth of your child. *To proceed with the baptism, you will need to:*



- Complete the baptismal information form.
- Obtain a certified copy of the birth certificate from the courthouse in the county the individual was born.
- ◆ Have the godparent take the sponsor sheet to their Catholic Church to be signed stating they are a registered and participating member of the parish.

Sacrament of Marriage



Marriage in the Catholic Church is the covenant by which a man and a woman establish between themselves a partnership for life. Through the marriage preparation time, the couple grows in their understanding of one another and a plan for their life together. Engaged couples are asked to call the

parish office to make an appointment with Fr. Michal to set up their wedding date. Please allow a minimum of six months in advance so all paperwork can be completed. Couples will be asked to participate in a Pre-Cana class, complete an online Foccus test, and attend a Natural Family Planning workshop. We would love to help you prepare for this beautiful sacrament together and answer any questions you may have.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is the external reality of the love and forgiveness of God through sign, symbol, and prayer. Celebrating this ritual is the constant reminder of God's presence in our lives. In the Sacrament of Reconciliation, we partake in the mercy of God. Healing of sins is given through the ministry of the Church, and we are reconciled to God and to one another.



Reconciliation is celebrated Saturdays at 3:00pm, 30 minutes prior to all weekday Masses, Adoration on the first Monday of the month from 7:00pm to 8:00pm, and anytime by appointment with the parish priest.

The Sacrament of Confirmation and First Communion





Confirmation is the Sacrament that strengthens the new life that began with Baptism. Confirmation seals a person with the gifts of Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude (Courage), Knowledge, Piety (Reverence), and Fear of the Lord (Wonder and Awe). All parishes within the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois are restoring the Original Order of the Sacraments of Initiation. Therefore, Confirmation and Eucharist are received together, both during third grade. Sacred Heart & PSR students will receive Confirmation and First Communion at the Cathedral in Springfield on Saturday, April 29, 2023.
