## **Liturgy Committee Meeting**

November 28, 2023

On November 28th, the Sacred Heart Liturgy Committee met in the church narthex. After an opening prayer and a welcome to a new member, Amy Westjohn, the committee reviewed the notes from their August meeting in regards to the plans for Advent and Christmas. It was noted that the parish Christmas card looks great and is a nice reminder to place on our fridge or bulletin board to display all the happenings going on at church during this special time of year.

The committee then discussed Lent and Easter. Items discussed include Ash Wednesday and whether to place ashes on the top of the head versus the forehead, a possible format for the Lenten retreat, and all Triduum and Easter related services and Masses. Father Michal shared that we should have 5 people coming into the Catholic church at the Easter Vigil. Praise be to God!

Next, the group discussed solemnities and the importance of these dates in the Catholic calendar. Individual churches celebrate solemnities in various ways. At Sacred Heart, we have chosen to celebrate solemnities with the use of 6 altar candles, incense, and distribution of the Body and Blood of Christ.



## **IRA DISTRIBUTIONS**

The age for mandatory IRA distributions is age 72. When you choose to make your distribution to Sacred Heart Parish from your IRA, the contribution counts towards your required minimum distribution and is NOT included in your adjusted gross income (AGI). This could qualify you for tax breaks tied to your AGI and reduce or eliminate taxes on your Social Security benefits.
