A Christmas Message from Fr. Michal Rosa

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Over the years, many of our Christmas traditions have come to center around gifts. Gifts for our family, our friends, our neighbors, our coworkers, maybe even gifts for our pets! So much time and attention is given to picking out just the right thing for the special people in our lives. But, what about our gifts for Jesus?

It may seem odd to think about what gift we can possibly give Jesus, our Savior who is truly man and truly God. However, our gifts to Jesus are, most definitely, the most important gifts of all! The Magi brought gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh to the newborn King. The shepherds and animals brought companionship and love to a lonely stable. Christmas provides an invitation for us to consider what gifts we might bring to Jesus.

What gift is the best gift? As demonstrated by the saints, the best gift is the gift of self! The saints offered their services to God, their time and talent, and their worship and love. Christmas tells us about God's infinite love for us. As we look upon the baby Jesus lying in a manger, we can realize that God loves us more than we deserve. God's love is without limits! St. John even tells us that "God is love". In one sense, God doesn't need anything. But there is one thing He does not have... something that only WE can give Him... our love. God won't force us to love him. He has given us free will and He respects this gift to us. We are free so that we can love. But, that also means we can choose not to love. What will you choose?

In the Gospel of Matthew, we read: 'Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me.' The beauty of this verse is that showing love to others is a way to also show love to Jesus.

We encourage you to spend a few minutes this Christmas reflecting on your gifts to the Christ Child. Spend some time in prayer, talking with Jesus about what your gifts could be. It could be simple things like:

- * Forgiving someone.
- * Calling someone who is lonely.
- * Doing a special act of kindness for a loved one.
- * Doing a household chore for another.
- * Making a commitment to be more faithful to Sunday Mass.
- * Going to make a good confession.
- * Starting a good prayer routine in the coming year.

In the end, when we stand before God, we will want to bring Him a gift. The Shepherds were unexpectedly called before the throne of God. We will all, at some point in our lives, "unexpectedly" stand before the throne of God in heaven. *Will we be ready?*

IRA DISTRIBUTIONS: The age for mandatory IRA distributions is age 72. When you choose to make your distribution to Sacred Heart Parish from your IRA, the contribution counts towards your required minimum distribution and is NOT included in your adjusted gross income (AGI). This could qualify you for tax breaks tied to your AGI and reduce or eliminate taxes on your Social Security benefits.
