YEAR-END GIVING

IRS EXTENDS A TAX BREAK FOR 2021

The US government has extended a tax break through 2021 at the rate of \$300 for individuals and \$600 for married couples filing jointly. Taxpayers who don't itemize deductions may take a charitable deduction for cash contributions made in 2021 to qualifying charities. If you've felt God leading you to make a gift to Sacred Heart Parish, this may be the perfect timing for you.

GIFTS OF CASH

The most popular way to make a gift is with cash or a check. To take a deduction for the gift on your 2021 tax return, your gift must be dropped off at the parish office by Thursday, December 30, 2021, or postmarked on or before December 31, 2021.

IRA DISTRIBUTIONS

As of December 31, 2019, the age for beginning mandatory IRA distributions is age 72. When you choose to make your distribution to Sacred Heart Parish from your IRA, the contribution counts towards your required minimum distribution and is NOT included in your adjusted gross income (AGI). This could qualify you for tax breaks tied to your AGI and reduce or eliminate taxes on your Social Security benefits.
