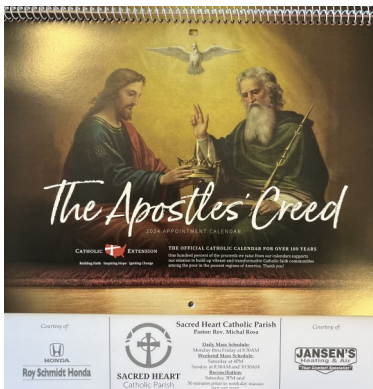

Reminder that this weekend we are officially switching to the Saint Augustine Hymnals. You will now notice a row of letters/numbers at the top of the song board. The letter (A, B, or C) will denote which liturgical year we are in. The following number will denote the page number for the readings for that day's Mass. (In the example shown here, we are in liturgical year 'B' and the readings can be found on page 954.) The remaining rows of numbers will denote song numbers—as they have in the past.

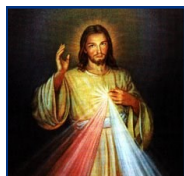


Help Spread the Faith: Learn to Make Rosaries for the Missions

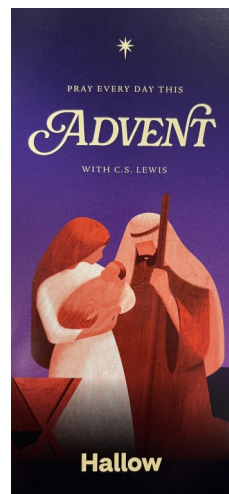
SHS students will be participating in various Advent projects this year.

Our SHS kindergarten students will be sharing a living Advent wreath with our school family. Each week we will gather in the gym to ‘light the candle’ on the special wreath. Some kindergarteners will stand in a circle to form the wreath, while others will stand in the center to represent the candles. This is a special way for them to bring the Advent season to life as we prepare for the coming of baby Jesus.

We are excited to have our Advent wreath in front of the altar this year! Special thanks to Bierman Welding for welding a new stand which displays the wreath beautifully in front of church. Advent wreaths and candles are full of symbolism, making them an extra special part of the Advent season. The wreath itself, which is made of various evergreens, signifies continuous life. The circle of the wreath, which has no beginning or end, symbolizes the eternity of God, the immortality of the soul, and the everlasting life we find in Christ. The four candles represent the four Sundays of Advent, and they respectively symbolize hope, peace, joy, and love.

- Advent week 1 – Hope: Prophecy Candle (purple)
- Advent week 2 – Peace: Bethlehem Candle (purple)
- Advent week 3 – Joy: Shepherd’s Candle (rose)
- Advent week 4 – Love: Angel’s Candle (purple)

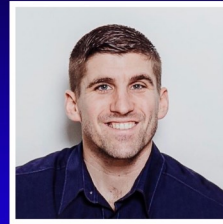
