Please pick up your free Lenten copy of the Word among us. The booklet has the daily meditations and readings from Ash Wednesday through Easter. There are many articles on how to pattern your daily prayers and how to do God's will. As we journey through Lent, may we all enhance our prayer life.

We are excited to announce that we are adding some beautiful artwork to our church and parish center! For centuries, artists have been interested in and inspired by the lives of Christ, the Virgin Mary, and the saints. It is fascinating to see how those artists interpret the stories and people of the Bible, and then portray them in their artwork. These religious paintings help us visualize the truths Jesus taught, even more so when you contemplate and study the original images firsthand. You can find meaning behind every masterpiece! Such art has inspired generations of men and women to be more faithful to the teachings of our Lord.

Over the next 14 weeks, we will be introducing replicas of some of the most famous Catholic artwork to our church! Each week a different piece of artwork will be unveiled. *Thank you to the anonymous donor for the paintings!* 

This week's artwork was hung in the parish center. It depicts Jesus and the saints, and is a replica of famous artwork originally painted in an Italian church. Make sure to check it out when you come for the Fish Fry this Friday (4:00-7:00pm in the parish center)!



The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, Feb. 22, and ends just prior to the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. All



the faithful are urged to develop and maintain a voluntary program of self-denial (in addition to the Lenten regulations that follow), serious prayer, and performing deeds of charity and mercy, including the giving of alms.

### **Lenten Regulations**

- 1. **ABSTINENCE** Everyone <u>14</u> years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. FAST Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.
- 3. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.

Michelle Kruger will facilitate two small fellowship study groups in the church narthex during Lent.



The first one will begin on Tuesday, Feb. 21, after the 8:30am Mass and continue through Lent. The book will be "No Greater Love, a Biblical Walk

Through Christ's Passion" by Edward Sri.

Michelle will also facilitate another Lenten study group on the book "Holy is His Name" by Scott Hahn on Thursday nights during Lent at 6:00pm. Scott traces the meaning of holiness from its origins in Scripture to its appearance in our lives today. Soup will be served during the evening.






