Ash Wednesday is this week! We hope you will join us for Mass as we begin our Lenten journey. Ash Wednesday Mass times are 8:30am, 12:10pm, and 6:30pm. Please read pages 4 and 5 of this bulletin for details about all of our Lenten spiritual growth and fellowship opportunities!

Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends just prior to the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, when the Paschal Triduum begins. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully.



Father Michal will have a short palm-burning ceremony in front of the rectory garage on Tuesday, February 17, at 1:00pm. Come and join him! Please bring your old palms with you on Tuesday or drop them off to the church narthex on Monday between 8:00-4:30. The ashes from burnt palms are used at Masses on Ash Wednesday.



Please be in prayer for our third-grade SHS and PSR students receiving the sacraments of Confirmation and First Communion next Saturday at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Springfield.

May they feel the love of Jesus in their hearts and always follow Him. We will have a special recognition Mass for these students at the 10:30am Mass on Sunday, February 22. Everyone is invited to join us for this Mass.





Study Group - 9:15am on Tuesdays: Luke: The Story of Salvation Fulfilled


Everyone is welcome to join our morning study group in the church narthex on Tuesdays after 8:30am Mass. This 8-part study will start on Tuesday, February 17, and end on Tuesday, April 7.



Strengthen your prayer life like never before. The Gospel of Luke takes you on a journey that begins with the foretelling of John the Baptist's birth and culminates in Jesus' ascension into Heaven. In *Luke: The Story of Salvation Fulfilled*, you will witness key moments in salvation history including the Annunciation, the Nativity, his public ministry, and Jesus' suffering, death, and glorious Resurrection. There are parables found only in Luke, including the Prodigal Son, the Good Samaritan, and the rich man and Lazarus which show the mercy and compassion that Jesus has for each one of his children.

Men's Bible Study - 7:00pm on Thursdays: CRUX: Daily Lenten Meditations

All men are invited to join the men's bible study in the church narthex on Thursday evenings. This Lenten devotional will start on Thursday, February 19.



Join Fr. Columba Jordan, CFR, for daily Lenten meditations that will help you learn to rely on God's strength. Rooted in the Crux program's holistic balance of body and soul, the *Crux: Daily Lenten Meditations* devotional offers daily reflections and Scripture passages to help you pray, meditate, and surrender yourself to God. You will read through the entirety of the Gospel of Mark, reflecting on your identity as God's beloved child, and you'll respond through prayer and practical action. *Crux* helps you unite the physical and spiritual disciplines of fasting, exercise, Scripture reading, and a daily Examen into one transformative Lenten experience that will lead you closer to Christ.

Students read and act out the Stations, creating a visual reminder of what Jesus endured so that we might have eternal life. Being able to SEE and HEAR the Stations creates a spirit-filled experience, sure to prepare your heart for Holy Week. We invite you to join us for one or both of our Living Stations! It is a spiritually moving experience and a very special Sacred Heart tradition.

Lenten Retreat - March 23-25

Come enjoy food, fellowship, and spiritual growth at our Lenten Retreat, led by Fr. Michael Berndt. This is a great opportunity to turn our hearts back to God, purify our souls, and prepare for the celebration of Christ's resurrection.

Lenten Regulations

All the faithful are urged to develop and maintain a voluntary program of self-denial (in addition to the Lenten regulations that follow), serious prayer, and performing deeds of charity and mercy, including the giving of alms.

- 1. Abstinence** – Everyone 14 years of age and over should abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.
- 2. Fast** – Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 should fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On these two days of fast and abstinence, only one full meatless meal is permitted. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to each person's needs, but together these two should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids (including milk and fruit juices) are allowed.
