Dear Fr. Rosa,

Please give my gratitude to all the parishioners, staff, and council-members of Sacred Heart parish for a lovely parish visit this past weekend. I was happy to celebrate the Lord's resurrection with you all at the Saturday evening and Sunday morning Masses, and it was a great joy to impart the Holy Spirit and the Holy Eucharist to your 3rd Graders. They certainly beamed with joy upon receiving those sacraments, but that same divine joy was palpable through all the liturgies and encounters of the whole weekend. I thank everyone who sacrificed time, energy, and prayer to make the weekend possible, and I thank the Lord for the outpouring of His graces upon us all.

I also write to acknowledge and recall the truly blessed conversation we were able to have Sunday afternoon with members of the parish staff, finance and parish councils, school board, liturgy committee, and leaders in your Hispanic ministry. It was inspiring to hear of the many things that you already do across the four pillars of our Diocesan Synod, calling and nourishing disciples, and inviting them into a life given to the Lord in stewardship and service. Here I can only mention a few highlights from our conversation. The presence of greeters before and after Mass, in your beautiful narthex, was a reflection of how much the Lord cares about and knows each of us. To pray Morning Prayer, a decade of the rosary, and with your servers before Mass was profound, even if only part, of the many opportunities for prayer that you have available. I heard about studies and catechetical opportunities present at the Church and available at home. I also heard of and saw people serving the parish in countless ways: preparing, greeting, serving, singing, photographing, and even just cleaning-up. All evidence of God's grace!

I want to encourage the entire parish to take advantage of all these opportunities already present to draw near Our Lord, as well as to continue the conversations begun Sunday afternoon in finding new ways to build up our communion with each other, and with Jesus, especially in the Blessed Sacrament. Retreats, small-groups, personal-invites, classes, Adoration, Stewardship Sundays, and everything else there mentioned will continue to build that Catholic culture that I know you desire, and I know Jesus does too.

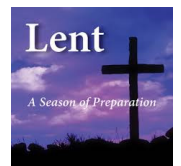
In the afternoon, Bishop Paprocki met with our councils for a brief overview of the parish and discussed upcoming events happening throughout the diocese.

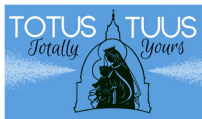
