## Invest in Kids Tax Credit

**Are you interested in contributing towards student scholarships for Sacred Heart School?** The Illinois *Invest in Kids* scholarship program is dedicated to ensuring every child in elementary and secondary school has access to the school of their choice. *Invest in Kids* allows parents the opportunity to choose the school they feel best meets the educational needs of their child. *Invest in Kids* offers a 75 percent income tax credit to individuals and businesses that contribute to a qualified Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO). The SGO then provides scholarships for students whose families meet the income requirements to attend qualified non-public schools.

### **Invest in Kids in Three Easy Steps . . .**

1. **Apply for a tax credit at MYTAX.ILLINOIS.GOV.** Applicants are required to first have a My Tax Illinois account. Visit [empowerillinois.org/donors](http://empowerillinois.org/donors) for instructions on creating an account and then applying for a tax credit.
2. **Donate to Empower Illinois within 60 days.** Once the application is approved, donate to Empower Illinois, the Scholarship Granting Organization used by the Diocese of Springfield, within 60 days.
3. **Designate Sacred Heart School.** During the donation process, donors have the option to donate to a specific Catholic school. Donations will stay with the designated schools and will not roll-over to regional or state funding.
