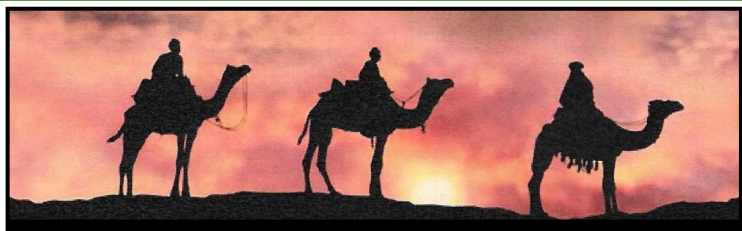

Sacred Heart School Christmas

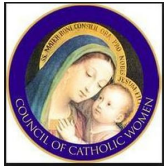

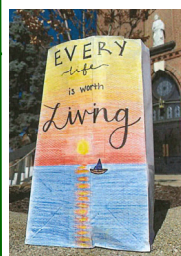
