April 4th, 2024 will mark the 75th anniversary of the St. Anthony hospital fire that claimed 77 lives and affected to some degree most everyone in the county. This tragedy reached national and international news, and was responsible for updating fire safety codes nationally, possibly saving hundreds of lives.

The ERVFA along with the City of Effingham will be erecting a statue on the site of the fire to stand as a memorial to the victims, the rescue personnel and those who assisted in the recovery and rebuilding process.
