You grow closer to someone by spending time with them. You build a close bond with someone by taking the time to nurture the relationship. Make it a priority to spend more time in prayer.



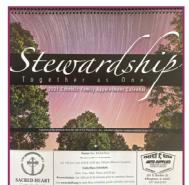
Missalettes for this liturgical year are available in the parish office.

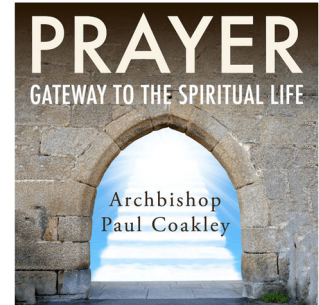

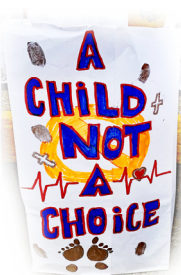
