You're Invited to Enroll in the Brown Scapular: An Opportunity for Committing to a Life of Prayer and Following Christ Daily

The brown scapular is made of cloth and is worn over the shoulders by cloth or a cord. It can also be a medal on a chain in some cases. It is a gift from Our



Blessed Mother and represents a life of prayer and is a sign of your commitment to follow Christ daily. There have been many miracles connected with the brown scapular.

The Church extends this extraordinary privilege to all the laity who wear the scapular and are willing to be invested in the Brown Scapular of the Carmelites. To be eligible for the promise, one must be enrolled in the Family of Carmel which can be done by any priest. They then wear the Brown Scapular to indicate that they place themselves under the special protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

The feast day of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel is July 16. In honor of this, I will have an Investiture of the Brown Scapular ceremony after the Saturday evening Mass on July 17 for anyone wishing to be enrolled in the Brown Scapular. The scapulars will be provided.

- ◆ Complete the baptismal information form.
- ♦ Obtain a certified copy of the birth certificate from the courthouse in the county the individual was born.
- ◆ Have the godparent take the sponsor sheet to their Catholic Church to be signed stating they are a registered and participating member of the parish.
