You're invited to enroll in the Brown Scapular: An Opportunity for Committing to a Life of Prayer and Following Christ Daily

Enrollment of the Brown Scapular will be on Saturday, July 19, after the 4:00pm Mass. Fr. Michal will distribute the scapulars, which are provided for all enrollees. You do not have to sign up in advance.

The brown scapular is made of cloth and is worn over the shoulders by cloth or a cord. It can also be a medal on a chain in some cases. It is a gift from Our Blessed Mother and represents a life of prayer and is a sign of your commitment to following Christ daily. There have been many miracles connected with the brown scapular.

The Church extends this extraordinary privilege to all the laity who wear the scapular and are willing to be invested in the Brown Scapular of the Carmelites. To be eligible for the promise Our Blessed Mother gave to St. Simon Stock, that whoever dies wearing the brown scapular will not burn in eternal fire, one must be enrolled in the Family of Carmel which can be done by a priest. They then wear the Brown Scapular to indicate that they place themselves under the special protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
