Beginning-of-the-year Payments:

Beginning-of-the-year payments are due with your August tuition payment on August 1. Each of these payments needs to be on separate checks. These payments include:

 - Grade K-5 lunches = \$2.80/day
 - Grades 6-8 have the option of a regular tray (\$2.80/day) or a tray with side salad (\$3.25/day)
