Would you like to join us on a 1-day pilgrimage to the Beatification Mass for Peoria's Archbishop Fulton Sheen? The Mass is on Thursday, September 24, in St. Louis. **We are considering taking a bus but need to know how much interest there is. If you are interested in going or want more information, please contact the parish office ASAP.** Tickets are selling fast so we need to reserve ours right away if we are taking a group.

Who is Archbishop Fulton Sheen? For decades, Archbishop Sheen — renowned for his powerful preaching, missionary zeal, and ability to communicate the Gospel through media — has inspired tens of millions. Now, the Church will formally recognize his holiness by raising him to the rank of "Blessed," bringing Archbishop Sheen one final step closer to canonization as a saint.

What Beatification Means: Beatification is the second stage in the process of canonization. When a person is beatified, they are given the title "Blessed" and are recognized as having lived a life of heroic virtue, offered their life for others, or suffered martyrdom. For beatification, the Church usually requires one verified miracle attributed to their intercession. The miracle attributable to Archbishop Sheen's intercession occurred in 2010 when a baby in Central Illinois was born lifeless and did not breathe for 61 minutes. As doctors were about to declare him dead, he suddenly began breathing. Today, James Fulton Engstrom is healthy.

Anima Christi Prayer

The Anima Christi is an optional, devotional prayer traditionally recited for thanksgiving after Holy Communion. Although we will no longer be praying it out loud together, we do invite everyone to pray it privately after Communion each time you come for Mass. Regarding liturgical law, it is a private devotion; it is not required by the General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM). Cardinal Francis Arinze, as the former Prefect of the Vatican's Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, has emphasized the importance of maintaining the integrity of the Roman Rite. While he strongly promotes deep Eucharistic devotion—such as visiting the Blessed Sacrament and showing proper reverence during Mass—he has also stressed that priests should not arbitrarily add to or omit texts from the liturgy. However, reciting the Anima Christi privately in the pew after receiving Holy Communion is a form of personal thanksgiving rather than part of the liturgy itself. In this context, Cardinal Arinze, in harmony with the Church's teaching, would encourage such a practice as a means of fostering a deeper union with Christ in the Eucharist.

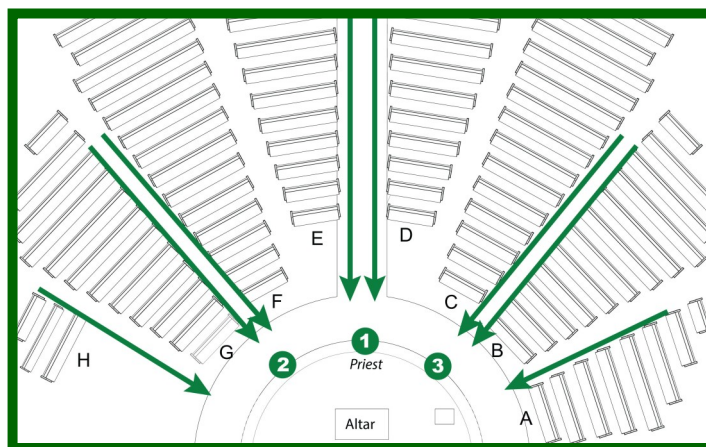

Communion Procedures:

We have received feedback from multiple parishioners requesting some changes to our Communion procedures. With these requests in mind, Communion will proceed as follows:

- * Fr. Jarek will always distribute Communion from the center aisle.
- * Eucharistic Ministers will stand between rows F & G, and B & C. When finished with those rows, they will slide over to rows H and A respectively.
- * Those coming up for Communion should come down the aisle side-by-side (between rows F/G, D/E, and B/C). Upon receiving Communion, they will turn and return to their pews on the opposite side. Rows H and A will come down the inner aisle and return on the outer aisle.
- * We will continue to only distribute the sacred blood during solemnities.

Additionally, new flooring and bathroom stall partitions are going in our school bathrooms this week.

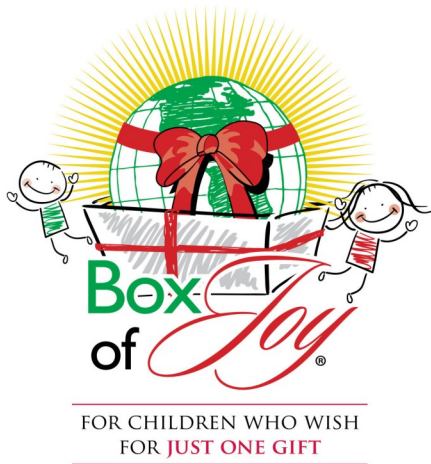


The old tile floor was damaged in multiple places with cracks and raised areas. The new epoxy finish on the floor will be easier to clean and maintain, and will also be safer with better traction and useability. The old green partitions were original to the building (1997) and were starting to rust with age. These new bathroom features will look updated, be more welcoming, and provide for easier cleanup and maintenance options.

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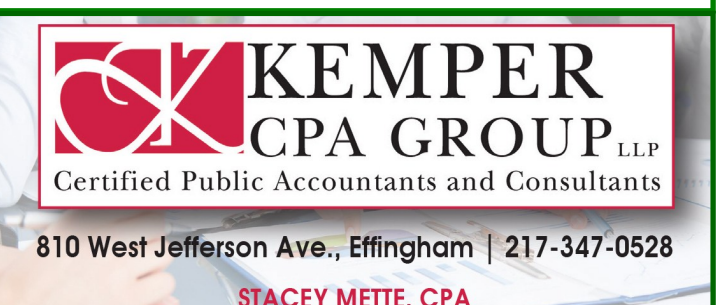


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
