# Sacred Heart Parish Picnic - June 24 & 25



### Here's how you can help:

Volunteer: We still have openings in many of the stands and could use your help! Contact the parish office at 217.347.7177 to volunteer.

Make / Bring Desserts: Each family is encouraged to make two desserts for the Picnic Dinner AND two cakes for the Cake Walk. Dessert boxes will be available in the back of the church starting mid-June. Desserts should be labeled for easy identification in the kitchen and should be delivered early Saturday and Sunday. You can take them into the school lobby or pull up to the curb by the canopy in front of the school. Someone will be there to help carry in desserts. Cakes, cupcakes, rice crispy treats, and cookies are great for the Cake Walk. Our dinner guests love pies! We need regular fruit pies, as well as sugar-free and gluten-free desserts.

Share Your Goodies: Homemade baked-goods, fresh fruit and vegetables, and home-canned goods are needed for the Country Store. Gather some things from the garden or package some baked goods into take-home containers and share your freshly canned goods with the Country Store. Please bring them to the school lobby on Sunday morning.

Get Creative: We need items for the Fancy Works Stand and the Mystery Box! If you can make something out of just about anything, please share your talents!
