is the fourth of July. Please plan to join us in prayer!

This weekend, we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity. The Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and life... the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them" (CCC234). Trinity means three, so when we discuss the Holy Trinity we mean the Father (God), Son



(Jesus), and Holy Spirit. The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men "and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin".



National Eucharistic Revival will begin on the Feast of Corpus Christi. This revival is a three-year effort to reinvigorate our devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. It takes time to kindle a living, loving relationship with Jesus Christ. The Eucharistic Revival

allows three years for discernment, encounter, and grassroots response on the diocesan, parish, and individual levels.

The Feast of Corpus Christi will be celebrated on Sunday, June 19. Following the 10:30am Mass, join in our procession, stopping at four different altars around Sacred Heart Church. Our First Communicants are invited to lead the procession. Come sing and pray in this procession which concludes with reposition back inside the church.


