A Note from Bishop Paprocki . . .

On April 11, 2021, I granted a dispensation from Mass for people in certain categories, such as those over 65 years of age or who have underlying medical conditions. Effective June 12, 2021, I have issued a decree to withdraw the dispensation and encourage everyone to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. If you believe you can not attend Mass, you are encouraged to talk to your parish priest, Fr. Michal, who may grant a dispensation in individual cases for a just reason. Those who are ill are excused and do not need a dispensation.

A note from Fr. Michal . . .

As we open up the church, I ask that anyone who has a missalette to bring it to Mass and leave it in the pew for others to use as well. A limited amount of missalettes were ordered for this year. Also, our ushers will begin taking up the collection during Mass next weekend. Please continue to sing along with our cantors. I will announce any changes at Mass during the next couple of weeks. I appreciate your support and patience!


