A note from Fr. Michal . . .

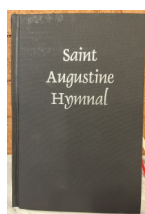


We would like to extend a very Happy Father's Day to all of the fathers and grandfathers in our parish and community!

This weekend you will notice new hymnals in the pews! I am excited about these, as they will help each of us gain a deeper understanding of the music and readings we share each week.

This *Saint Augustine Hymnal* has a different format than the *Breaking Bread* missalettes we have had in the past. Each year the church follows readings based on which liturgical year it is — 'A, B, or C'. Currently, we are in year 'A'. These hymnals include the lectionary for all three years (A, B, and C), and can be used from year to year, without having to be replaced every 12 months. Music is in the front of the book, with the readings in the back. This weekend's readings can be found on page 908. The *Breaking Bread* missalettes will remain in the pews until December 1, at which time we will officially transition to the new *Saint Augustine Hymnal*.
