

A light meal with dessert will be served immediately following.

Sacrament of Baptism

The Sacrament of Baptism initiates an individual into the Catholic Church. It brings new life by water and the Holy Spirit to free them from original sin. To begin the process, please

set up an appointment to meet with Fr. Michal for a short baptismal session to discuss the Rite of Baptism. It helps to have this done prior to the birth of your child. *To proceed with the baptism, you will need to:*

- ♦ Complete the baptismal information form.
- ♦ Obtain a certified copy of the birth certificate from the courthouse in the county the individual was born.
- ♦ Have the godparent take the sponsor sheet to their Catholic Church to be signed stating they are a registered and participating member of the parish.
