### Message from Fr. Michal . . .

In keeping with the call of Pope Francis for dialogue, accompaniment, and collaboration among the lay faithful, religious, and clergy, Bishop Paprocki is hosting



a diocesan wide listening session on Sunday, March 27, from 2:00pm to 4:00pm. In our Mattoon Deanery, these sessions will take place at Sacred Heart Church, 405 S. Henrietta in Effingham, and the Immaculate Conception Parish Center, 1920 Richmond Avenue in Mattoon.

The session will include a video presentation from the Bishop, small group discussion, small group leaders reporting to the local group, and then the local group reporting to the other groups assembled around the diocese.

The discussion will focus on questions about:

- 1) How we see Discipleship happening in our local communities and challenges moving forward.
- 2) How we see Discipleship happening as a Diocesan Church. What steps can we take to further spread the Gospel?
- 3) How do we respond as a Church to increasing cultural challenges to our Catholic Christian vision and desire to serve?

I invite every Catholic in our diocese to be a part of this process. If you cannot be here in person, please keep this effort in your prayers.



I encourage you to attend Mass next Saturday, April 2, or Sunday, April 3, as Msgr. Hoefler will begin our Lenten Retreat. Presentations, reconciliation, Mass, and socials will be held Monday through Wednesday. A complete schedule is on page 2 of this bulletin. *Please come and bring your family and friends*.


