The artwork we are unveiling this week is Rembrandt's Prodigal Son. The Prodigal Son, also known as the Lost Son, is one of the best known parables of Jesus. It appears only in the Gospel of Luke in the New Testament of the Bible. In this painting, Rembrandt interprets the Christian idea of mercy with an extraordinary solemnity, as though this were his spiritual testament to the world. The father's love and acceptance of his

long-lost son is demonstrated through the expressive lighting and coloring of the painting. This painting technique, along with the selective simplicity of the setting, help us to feel the full impact of the event.
