Lent is a season in which we call to mind Christ's Paschal Mystery in a special way. It is a time to renew our devotion to the Lord through increased prayer, fasting,



and almsgiving. In doing these things, we find ourselves following the Way of the Cross, the path of eternal victory. Sacred Heart Parish is offering many opportunities to make this Lent a very special time to prepare for Easter. I invite you to join us for Adoration & Reconciliation on Mondays at 7:00pm, Stations of the Cross on Fridays at 5:30pm, and study groups at 9:15am on Tuesdays, and at 12:10pm on Wednesdays. Also, mark your calendar for the Lenten Retreat on April 4-6.



This Sunday, Pierce Borah and Joseph Grupe, along with their families, will participate in the Rite of Election at the Cathedral in Springfield. Please pray for them as they continue their faith journey to become members of the Catholic church at the Easter vigil.

Holy water represents the reminder of the waters of Baptism through which we were first joined to Christ. When we enter a church and place our hand in the holy water font, making the Sign of the Cross, we are recalling our Baptism. We are asking God for purity as we approach the celebration of the sacred mysteries.



The holy water has been blessed by the pastor and is used in baptism and to bless individuals, churches, homes, and articles of devotion. The holy water is reserved in the special baptismal font. At Sacred Heart, the baptismal font is placed in the back of church and easily accessible for all entering and leaving church.



I urge you to pray for the people of Ukraine, for an end to violence and war, and for the conversion of hearts and minds to faith in the Prince of Peace. Growing up in Poland, Ukraine is Poland's neighbor three hours away

from my parent's house. I am familiar with the areas that are now in the middle of the conflict and I ask you to please pray for them.


Praying with Body, Mind, and Voice . . .

"Silence in the Liturgy allows the community to reflect on what has been heard and experienced, and to open its heart to the mystery celebrated" (Sing to the Lord, no. 118). We gather in silence, taking time to separate ourselves from the concerns of the world and enter into the sacred action. We reflect on the readings in silence. We may take time for silent reflection and prayer after Holy Communion. These times of silence are not merely time when nothing happens; rather, they are opportunities for us to enter more deeply in what God is doing in the Mass, and like Mary, to keep "all these things, reflecting on them" in our hearts. (Lk 2:19)


Sitting is the posture of listening and meditation, so the congregation sits for the pre-Gospel readings and the homily and may also sit for the period of meditation following Communion. All should strive to assume a seated posture during the Mass that is attentive rather than merely at rest.
