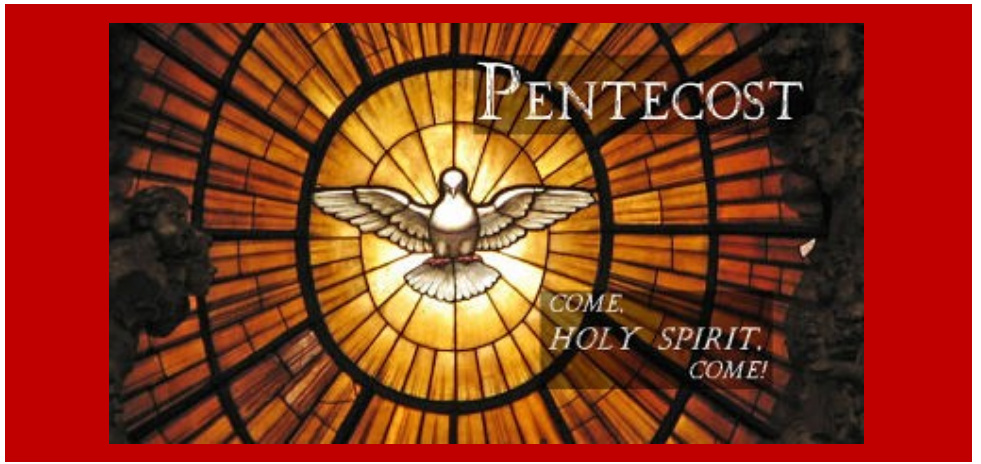

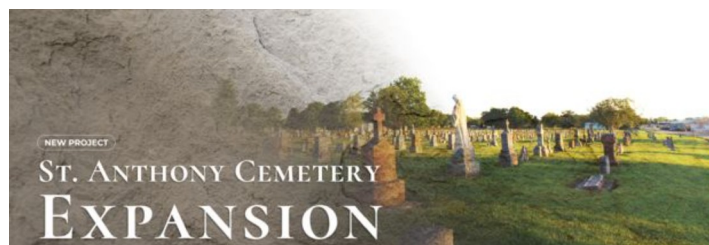

Beginning in 1857, a year before a Catholic church would open its doors in Effingham County, a small cemetery named after Saint Anthony was founded in Effingham. Much has changed since the 1850's, but the reality of death and the need to lay our departed to rest has stayed with us - so too our cemetery.

Our cemetery now, for a second time, comes close to its capacity and it is expanding so that it can live on. The construction expense estimate at \$100,000 is considered an extraordinary one, in comparison to the funds collected for the cemetery's normal care and maintenance. We are, therefore, asking for your prayerful consideration of this need as a shared expense between St. Anthony and Sacred Heart Parishes. Visual descriptions of the proposed plans are in the narthex this weekend.

If you have any questions about the Cemetery Expansion project, please talk with one of Sacred Heart's cemetery board members: Jerry Steppe, Billi Jansen, or Kevin Perkins.
