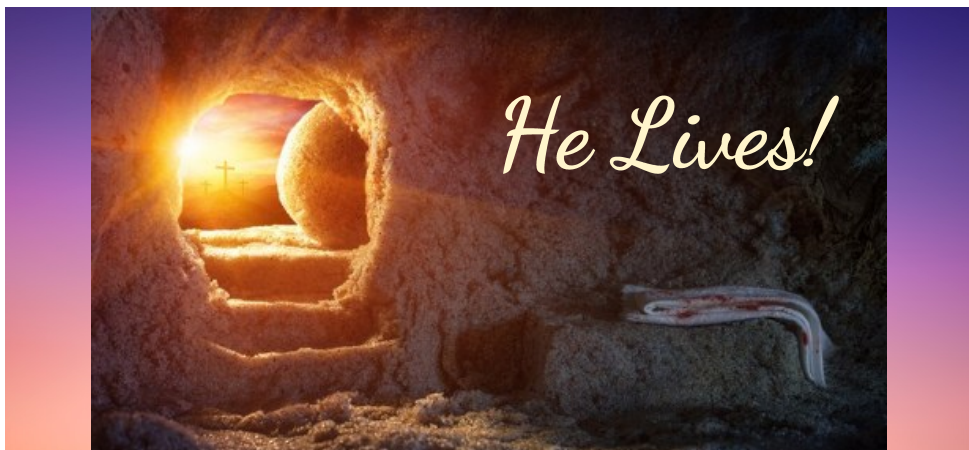

To my beloved parishioners,

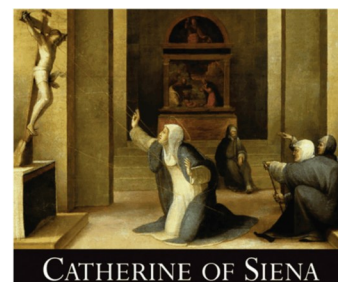
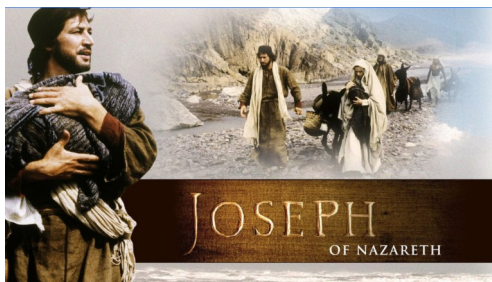

Our SHS Thursday morning group “Common Grounds” recently discussed Saint Faustina. After watching a brief video about her and discussing her significance and relics, the group went into church to view the first-class relic of Saint Faustina that we house at Sacred Heart Church. Fun Fact! - When the relic was installed at Sacred Heart, Haylie Roedl, who is in our Common Grounds group, was the server who carried it down the aisle at the beginning of Mass! Common Grounds is open to all seventh- and eighth-grade girls and meets each Thursday at 7:30am in the narthex.

The “Wave of Faith” Bible study began this spring and is open to all SHS eighth-grade boys. The group meets every Thursday morning at 7:30am and is led by Miss Joye and Gabe Traub. This study coincided nicely with the new Bibles awarded to all Sacred Heart students, and the boys will carry their Bibles into their high school years. Topics such as Jonah and the Whale, The Shroud of Turin, Revelations’ letters to churches, and Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane have been explored. 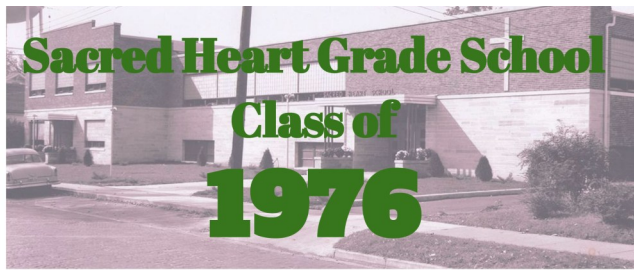
