Message from Fr. Michal . . .

This Sunday, we celebrate All Saints' Day. We are called to imitate and venerate saints because of their virtuous lives, martyrdom, and their offering of life for others. When we ask the saints to pray for us, we ask them to intercede for us here on earth, which we profess in the Creed at Mass. Let us ask the Lord for the grace to be simple and humble people, the grace to be meek, and to work for justice and peace. Above all, ask for the grace to let ourselves be forgiven by God so as to become instruments of His mercy.

PLENARY INDULGENCES

During the month of November,
you will have the
opportunity to get
plenary indulgences.

On October 23, the Vatican extended the availability of certain plenary indulgences for the souls in Purgatory, amid concerns about avoiding large gatherings of people in churches or cemeteries and including those confined to home due to the pandemic. According to the decree, certain indulgenced acts, which can help to remit the temporal punishment due to sin for those who have died in a state of grace, can be obtained through the entire month of November 2020.

To receive a plenary indulgence, you need to first go to confession, then each day during this time period you are required to say prayers, receive communion, be free of venial sin, and make a visit to the cemetery Nov. 1-8. I will be going after the 8:30am daily Masses to the cemetery. On Sunday, Nov. 1, and Nov. 8, I will be going after the 8:30am Mass. Please join me each day.

An indulgence is defined as "the remission before God of the temporal punishment due for sins already forgiven as far as their guilt is concerned." The first thing to note is that forgiveness of a sin is separate from punishment for the sin. Through sacramental confession we obtain forgiveness, but we aren't let off the hook as far as punishment goes. Indulgences are two kinds: partial and plenary. A partial indulgence removes part of the temporal punishment due for sins. A plenary indulgence removes all of it. A plenary indulgence is the remission, through the merits of Christ and the saints, through the Church, of all temporal punishment due to sin already forgiven. This punishment may come either in this life, in the form of various sufferings, or in the next life, in purgatory. What we don't get rid of here, we suffer there.

Welcome to Sacred Heart - we're glad that you're here!


Parish News



A note from Fr. Michal . . .

On Monday, Nov. 2, All Souls Day, I will celebrate the Mass of Remembrance at 7:00pm; therefore, the server's meeting will be held on Monday, Nov. 9, at 6:00pm, in church. Adoration will follow at 7:00pm, in church. *Please mark your calendars.*



All Souls Day, Monday, Nov. 2, there will be three Masses: 8:30am (live-streamed), 12:10pm, and a 7:00pm "Mass of Remembrance" for all parishioners who have died this past year.

Everyone is welcome to Mass. No signup required.

At Sacred Heart Parish, we have two beautiful November customs:

The Book of Remembrances and Jacob's Ladder

1. Jacob's Ladder is the colloquial name of a bridge between the earth and heaven that the biblical Patriarch Jacob dreamt about. Origin explains there are two ladders in the life of a Christian: the ladder we climb on earth to grow in virtue and the ladder we travel after death, climbing up to the heavens towards the light of God. So, if you have a picture of a **family member who died this year**, we encourage you to **place it on the ladder on All Souls Day, Nov. 2**, where we all can keep the memory of your loved one alive in thought and prayer.

2. The Book of Remembrances, also known as the "Book of Life," gives us an opportunity to record the names of our deceased loved ones for the parish to remember in prayer during the month of November. It will be placed near the Jacob's ladder in the Narthex. We invite you to take some prayer time, approach the book, and write the names of family and friends **who have died since November of 2019**. During November, at all the Masses, we will pray for those "whose names are recorded in our Book of Remembrances." For those we have loved in life will remain in our hearts forever.

A special memorial card with the names of our parishioners who have passed away since Nov. 2019, to the end of Oct. 2020, will be available at Mass and in the Narthex by the Book of Remembrances.

In preparation for the upcoming election, resources about the importance of voting and preparing to vote can be found on the diocesan website at www.dio.org.



Information includes: information from USCCB on Faithful Citizenship; Bishop Paprocki's statement on the upcoming election; reflection from Bishop Joseph Naumann, Chair of the USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities; election information from the Catholic Conference of Illinois (CCI); and the diocesan policy on Political Activity and Voter Education.

You can also pray the prayer below:

O Most Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of Mercy, at this most critical time, we entrust the United States of America to your loving care.

Most Holy Mother, we beg you to reclaim this land for the glory of your Son. Overwhelmed with the burden of the sins of our nation, we cry to you from the depths of our hearts and seek refuge in your motherly protection.

Look down with mercy upon us and touch the hearts of our people. Open our minds to the great worth of human life and to the responsibilities that accompany human freedom.

Free us from the falsehoods that lead to the evil of abortion and threaten the sanctity of family life. Grant our country the wisdom to proclaim that God's law is the foundation on which this nation was founded, and that He alone is the True Source of our cherished rights to life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness.

O Merciful Mother, give us the courage to reject the culture of death and the strength to build a new Culture of Life.


