This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King. Christ's kingship is rooted in the Church's teaching on the Incarnation. *Jesus is fully God and fully man.* He is both the divine Lord and the man who suffered and died on the Cross. One person of the Trinity unites himself to human nature and reigns over all creation as the Incarnate Son of God.

Pope Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925 in response to growing secularism and atheism. He recognized that attempting to "thrust Jesus Christ and his holy law" out of public life would result in continuing discord among people and nations. This solemnity reminds us that while governments come and go, Christ reigns as King forever.

Advent starts on Sunday, November 30! We have multiple spiritual growth opportunities to help prepare you for the birth of our Savior!

Join us on Mondays during Advent!

On December 1, 15, and 22, we will be hosting the following in church:

- ⇒ 6:30am Rorate (candlelight) Mass
(no 8:30am Mass these days)
- ⇒ Eucharistic Adoration from 7:00am - 8:00pm
- ⇒ Confession from 7:00pm - 8:00pm
(December 22 will be a special Night of Confession with 4 priests available.)

Please note: Any time you pray at Eucharistic Adoration, you can receive a partial indulgence. A plenary indulgence is granted when you visit the most Blessed Sacrament during Adoration for at least 30 minutes. (All other qualifications for plenary indulgence still apply: go to Confession, receive Communion the same day, say prayers, and be free of venial sin. If you are interested in more information, please talk to Fr. Michal or contact the parish office.)

Due to it being the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, Monday, December 8, has a different schedule than the other Mondays in Advent. This is the holy day of obligation celebrating that the Virgin Mary was free of original sin from the moment of her conception. Masses will be held on Monday, December 8 at 8:30am, 12:10pm, and 6:30pm. Please join us!



During Advent, our men's group will be studying the book *Waiting Well* by Fr. Mike Schmitz. All men are invited! They meet on Thursdays at 7:00pm in the church narthex. Any questions, contact Tom Purcell at 217-821-7077.

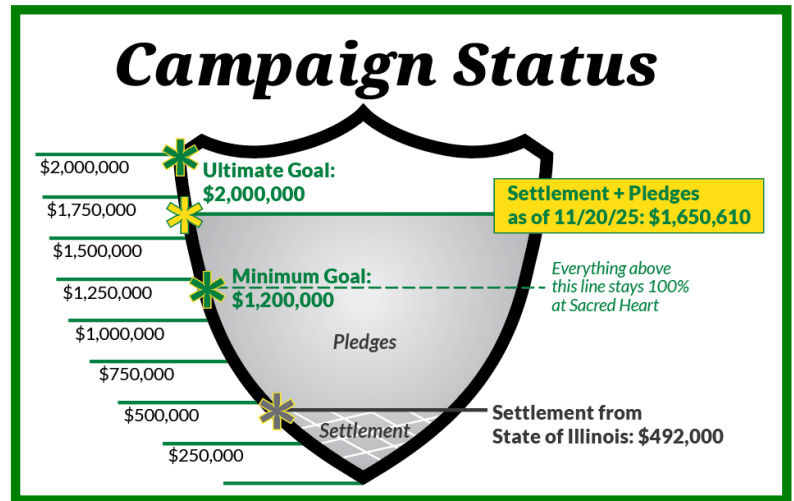


There is also a lot of helpful information and Advent resources on FORMED. FORMED is an online

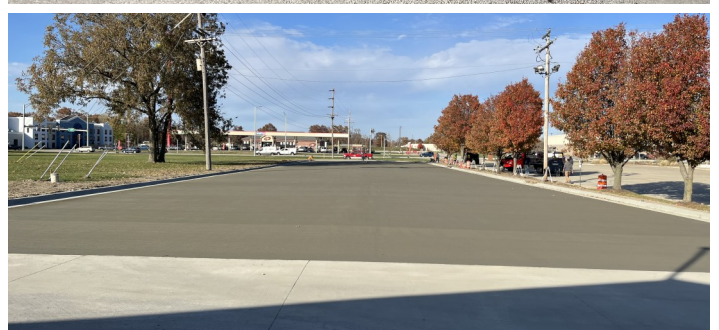


The JB Esker crew was out bright and early Monday morning (so early that it was still dark!) to start pouring concrete on the west parking lot.
