The Book of Remembrances and Jacob's Ladder

1. **Jacob's Ladder** - if you have a picture of a **family member who died this year**, we encourage you to **place it on the ladder**, where we all can keep the memory of your loved one alive in thought and prayer.
2. **The Book of Remembrances**, also known as the "Book of Life," gives us an opportunity to record the names of our deceased loved ones for the parish to remember in prayer during the month of November. We invite you to take some prayer time and write the names of family and friends **who have died since November of 2020**. During November, at all the Masses, we will pray for those "whose names are recorded in our Book of Remembrances."



No matter what your age or stage in life, no matter how comfortable (or uncomfortable) you are, your happiness tank is probably not full. There's a void in all of us that no amount of power, excitement, money, or possessions can completely fill. So, we search for that elusive thing we call true happiness. The Augustine Institute has a program to help us in that quest and it's called "Search". A series of

seven videos and the follow-up discussions with your fellow parishioners will help you find what you need, in your life, to help fill that void.

Join us on Wednesdays, at 6:30pm, in the Sacred Heart Parish Center, for *The Search* program. Together, we will search for the answers that each of us need.

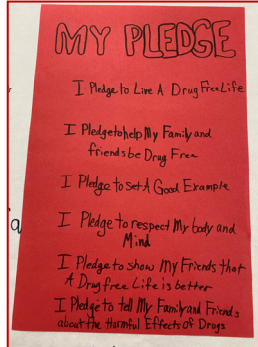
Sacred Heart School "Space Camp" Christmas Fundraiser Featuring Christmas Coffees and Wreaths
