PLENARY INDULGENCES

An indulgence is defined as "the remission before God of the temporal punishment due for sins already forgiven as far as their guilt is concerned."

On October 23, the Vatican extended the availability of certain plenary indulgences for the souls in Purgatory. According to the decree, certain indulgenced acts, which can help to remit the temporal punishment due to sin for those who have died in a state of grace, can be obtained through the entire month of November 2020.

To receive a plenary indulgence, you need to first go to confession, then each day during this time period you are required to say prayers, receive communion, be free of venial sin, and make a visit to the cemetery in November. I will be going after the 8:30am daily Masses to the cemetery. You can save one soul a day for each visit on eight different days. You are invited to join me each day.


Season of Stewardship

A note from Fr. Michal on October Count . . .

As we continue through these uncertain times, every aspect has changed in the way things are calculated and measured. We just completed our annual October Count and understandably it does not compare with our previous totals. However, it was interesting to see we had a monthly total of 1,361 people with an average weekly attendance of over 300 per weekend. There were also over 450 families who tuned in via Facebook and Youtube. As we can't calculate the number of viewers, I have spoken to several families who routinely gather together in a prayerful setting to watch Mass. The Spanish Mass attendance was 134 which was consistent with last year.


We will continue with our current arrangements of signup each week until the restrictions are lifted. Thank you for wearing a mask and social distancing. *We will get through this together.*

Social distancing will be observed per Diocese protocols. Families and friends of the deceased as well as all council Brothers are encouraged to pray for them. Financial



The Annual Catholic Services Appeal (ACSA) was the system in which we, Sacred Heart Parish, paid our Diocese for the support and services that they provide to us. For the 2019-2020 year, our

Parish's ACSA amount due to our Diocese was \$58,951.

Just recently, our Diocese has restructured how the parishes will compensate the Diocese for the support and services they provide. This new structure is called "Tithing" and no longer "ACSA".

The amount our Parish is expected to Tithe to our Diocese is now 10% of our annual church income. The amount we are expected to tithe for 2020-2021 is \$67,350.

As parishioners, we can send our Tithing money directly to the Diocese, as opposed to giving it first to Sacred Heart Parish. Donations given to Sacred Heart are considered income. If the Tithing money is sent directly to our Diocese, it keeps our Parish's income lower for the next year's Tithing assessment.

With this in mind, we ask that you prayerfully consider making your Tithing contribution directly to the Diocese to help us reach our goal with them. Your contribution directly to our Diocese's Tithing can be in place of your weekly contribution to Sacred Heart Parish. To make a Tithing contribution, simply write "Sacred Heart" in the memo line of your check to Diocese Parish Tithe.
