A note from Fr. Michal . . .

With November comes the opportunity for plenary indulgences. I will be going to the cemetery each day from November 1-8 after 8:30am Mass. Everyone is welcome! To receive a plenary indulgence, you need to first go to confession, then each day during this time period you are required to say prayers, receive Communion, be free of venial sin, and make a visit to the cemetery from November 1-8.

An indulgence is defined as "the remission before God of the temporal punishment due for sins already forgive as far as their guilt is concerned." The first thing to note is that forgiveness of a sin is separate from punishment for the sin. Through sacramental confession we obtain forgiveness, but we aren't let off the hook as far as punishment goes. Indulgences are two kinds: partial and plenary. A partial indulgence removes part of the temporal punishment due for sins. A plenary indulgence removes all of it. A plenary indulgence is the remission, through the merits of Christ and the saints, through the Church, of all temporal punishment due to sin already forgiven. This punishment may come either in this life, in the form of various sufferings, or in the next life, in purgatory. What we don't get rid of here, we suffer there.

Our All Saints' Day Masses will be Wednesday, November 1, at 8:30am, 12:10pm, and 6:30pm. All Saint's Day celebrates the feast or solemnity of all the saints in Heaven, both saints recognized by the Church as holy men and women *and* those who remain unknown. It is a holy day of obligation.

Our All Souls' Day Masses will be Thursday, November 2, at 8:30am, 12:10pm, and 6:30pm. The 6:30pm Mass will be a special Mass of Remembrance. All Souls' Day honors all of the faithful departed. Our Mass of Remembrance honors all parishioners and parishioners' loved ones who have passed away in the past year. Everyone is welcome, whether you have lost a loved one this year or not. It is simply a chance for us to come together to honor and remember those who have gone before us.



Please come for Eucharistic Adoration on Monday, November 6, between 9:00am-8:00pm. This is always a special opportunity for quiet prayer and reflection. Reconciliation will be offered from 7:00pm to 8:00pm. A sign up sheet is in the church narthex.
