Message from Fr. Michal . . .

Monday, November 1, is All Saints Day. On this day, we recall the holy men and women who, having completed their earthly journeys, now live forever with God. As a solemnity, Masses will be celebrated at



8:30am and 7:00pm. Please note, a server's meeting will still be at 6:15pm on Monday, Nov. 1; however, Adoration & Reconciliation will be moved to Monday, Nov. 8, at 7:00pm.



Tuesday, November 2, is All Soul's Day, the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed. Masses will be celebrated at 8:30am, 12:10pm, and 7:00pm. The 7:00pm Mass will be for all Sacred Heart parishioners who died this past year. We will once again have the Jacob's Ladder and the Book of Remembrance in the church. If you have a picture of a family

member who died this year, we encourage you to place it on the ladder on All Souls Day, Nov. 2, where we all can keep the memory of your loved one alive in prayer. The 8:30am & 7:00pm will be live-streamed.



From November 1-8, you will have the opportunity to get plenary indulgences.

To receive a plenary indulgence, you need to first go to confession, then each day during this time period you are required to say prayers, receive communion, be free of venial sin, and make a visit to the cemetery Nov. 1-8. I will be going after the 8:30am daily Masses to the cemetery. I will also go after the 4:00pm Saturday evening Mass and the 8:30am Sunday Mass (Nov. 6-7). Please join me each day.

An indulgence is defined as "the remission before God of the temporal punishment due for sins already forgiven as far as their guilt is concerned." The first thing to note is that forgiveness of a sin is separate from punishment for the sin. Through sacramental confession we obtain forgiveness, but we aren't let off the hook as far as punishment goes. Indulgences are two kinds: partial and plenary. A partial indulgence removes part of the temporal punishment due for sins. A plenary indulgence removes all of it. A plenary indulgence is the remission, through the merits of Christ and the saints, through the Church, of all temporal punishment due to sin already forgiven. This punishment may come either in this life, in the form of various sufferings, or in the next life, in purgatory. What we don't get rid of here, we suffer there.

At Sacred Heart Parish, we have two beautiful November customs: The Book of Remembrances and Jacob's Ladder

- 1. Jacob's Ladder is the colloquial name of a bridge between the earth and heaven that the biblical Patriarch Jacob dreamt about. Origin explains there are two ladders in the life of a Christian: the ladder we climb on earth to grow in virtue and the ladder we travel after death, climbing up to the heavens towards the light of God. So, if you have a picture of a family member who died this year, we encourage you to place it on the ladder on All Souls Day, Nov. 2, where we all can keep the memory of your loved one alive in thought and prayer.
- 2. The Book of Remembrances, also known as the "Book of Life," gives us an opportunity to record the names of our deceased loved ones for the parish to remember in prayer during the month of November. It will be placed near the Jacob's ladder in the church. We invite you to take some prayer time, approach the book, and write the names of family and friends who have died since November of 2020. During November, at all the Masses, we will pray for those "whose names are recorded in our Book of Remembrances." For those we have loved in life will remain in our hearts forever.

A special memorial card with the names of our parishioners who have passed away since November 2020, to the end of October 2021, will be available at Mass and in the church by the Book of Remembrances.

Confirmation with our PSR students entering 6th, 7th, and 8th grades will be celebrated at Sacred Heart Church on Sunday, November 14, at 2:00pm. PSR Confirmation practice will be Wednesday, November 10, at 6:30pm, in the church.



The SHS 6th-8th graders will celebrate it at Sacred Heart Church, on Sunday, November 21, at 2:00pm. SHS Confirmation practice will be Wednesday, Nov. 17, at 5:30pm, in the church.

Please continue to pray for our students as they continue their preparation for the sacrament.
