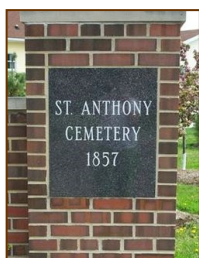

The rosary will be prayed:

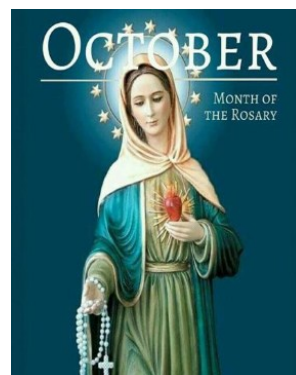
- Monday through Thursday following our 8:30am Mass

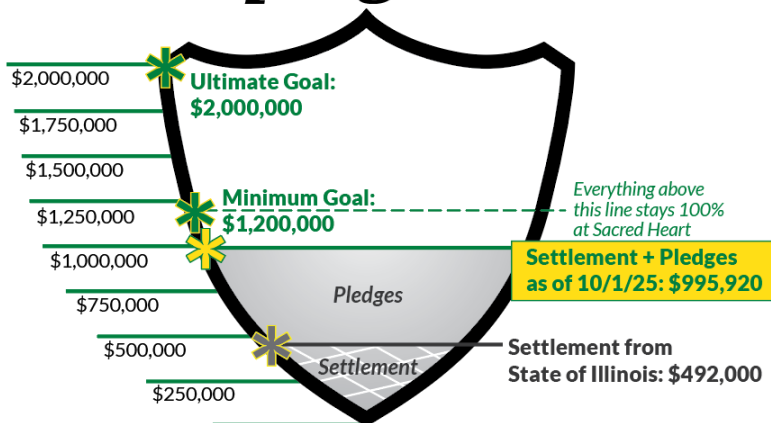

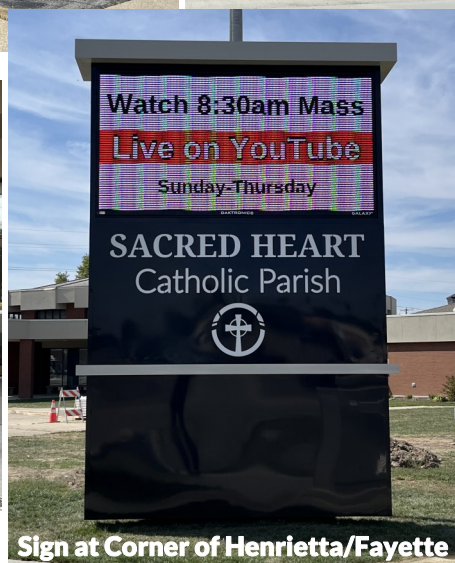
