Thank you for choosing Sacred Heart School!

We appreciate the opportunity to educate your child while fostering his/her faith.

Since 1892, Sacred Heart School has worked to provide a high-quality education, to teach 'others before self', and to create a Christ-centered environment where students can grow spiritually and academically.

The investment you make in your child's future, by sending him/her to Sacred Heart School, is one that will reap many benefits in these formative years.

Cost of Education

The actual cost to educate each student at Sacred Heart School is approximately \$6,700. Our parish believes in the mission of providing a high-quality Catholic education. Therefore, Sacred Heart Parish pays for a large portion of each Sacred Heart School student's education. This is made possible through the generosity of Sacred Heart parishioners and those who donate to the Sacred Heart School Annual Fund and/or Empower Illinois. Additionally, those who volunteer at the annual Sacred Heart picnic, PTA & Booster Club fundraisers, and those who purchase SCRIP cards are all helping raise money to offset the actual cost of education at Sacred Heart. Thanks to this, we are able to offer a tuition rate that reflects only *a portion* of the true cost of education.

Non-Parish Members

Sacred Heart School has a two-tiered tuition rate: Parish Members and Non-Parish Members. Since non-parish members do not contribute to our Sunday church collections (helping offset the amount the parish pays toward each student's tuition), they pay an additional amount per student for their tuition.

Tuition Assistance Options

Invest in Kids Act / Empower Illinois Scholarships

- Available to all families, regardless of church affiliation
- Awarded based on financial need and on a first come, first served basis
- Scholarships are funded by donations made to the Empower IL program
- A free application is available at www.EmpowerIllinois.org

Parish Scholarships

- Available only to registered and active members of Sacred Heart Parish
- Awarded based on financial need
- Scholarships are funded by Sacred Heart Parish
- A third-party vendor is utilized to ensure impartiality and confidentiality
- Applicants must also apply for the Invest in Kids/Empower Illinois Scholarship
- The deadline to apply for a parish scholarship is May 15, 2023.

SCRIP Program

- Families can purchase gift cards to local and national retailers while earning credit toward their tuition payments, and raising money for Sacred Heart School
- Rebates/credit amounts vary per retailer
- Many families earn between \$50-\$500 in tuition credit annually

Tuition Payments: Tuition payments begin July 1, 2023. We offer a \$100 discount if tuition and registration fee are both paid in full by July 1, 2023.

Registration Fee: Our registration fee is \$325 per student, is non-refundable, and applies to all students, regardless of their financial aid status. It can be combined with tuition payments, as shown in the chart below.

Late Enrollment: If enrolling at SHS after the first day of school, tuition will be pro-rated depending on start date. The full registration fee will be assessed for each student, regardless of start date.
