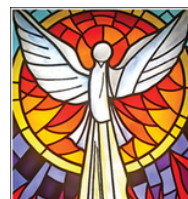


Please join us to celebrate the Feast Day of Saint Faustina on Wednesday, October 5, at the 8:30am Mass, with the introduction of her relic in our church.
