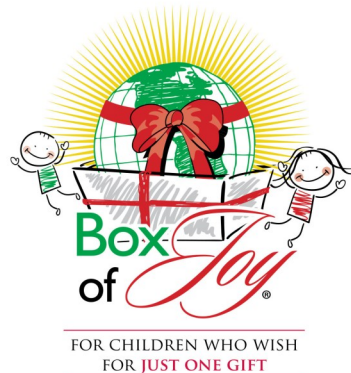
The parish office will be closed on Monday, September 7, in honor of Labor Day.

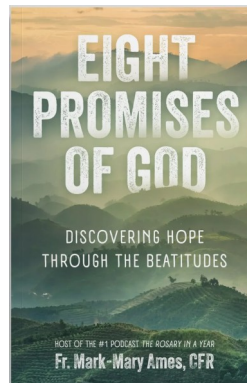

Sacred Heart Rosary Making Group Makes Rosaries for Beatification Mass!

Our next rosary making group will meet on Saturday, September 12, from 9:00-10:30am in the narthex. Everyone is welcome to make rosaries or learn how. Supplies are furnished. Normally we send our rosaries to the missions overseas, but this month we mailed out 352 world mission rosaries for the upcoming Beatification Mass of Bishop Sheen taking place in St. Louis. Everyone in attendance will receive a world mission rosary to be prayed before the Beatification Mass. Since they are expecting 75,000 attendees, rosary makers around the country were asked to make rosaries. We are privileged that we could take part in this special event through our rosaries!

The Family Life Center Vision Dinner is on Friday, September 11, with two meal options: a luncheon and a dinner. Sacred Heart parishioner, Cindy Goddard, is hosting a table at the luncheon meal at 11:30am. Valerie Kemme from St. Anthony is hosting a table at the evening meal at 6:30pm. DAILY PRAYER, DAILY PURPOSE

Faith formation at Sacred Heart School does not end with formal coursework. Each morning, before students enter their classrooms, our teachers gather together for prayer and reflection. This special time gives our faculty an opportunity to begin the school day united in faith and focused on their shared mission. Together, they ask for God's guidance in all they do throughout the day. They pray for the grace to remain Christ-centered in their words, their actions, their teaching, and their interactions with students and one another. Through prayer, study, reflection, and faithful teaching, our educators continue to grow in their own relationship with Christ while becoming even better prepared to help form the hearts and minds of our students. We are grateful for our teachers' dedication—not only to educating our students academically, but also to helping them grow as disciples of Christ. Please keep our teachers in your prayers as they continue this beautiful journey of faith formation. Thank you to our teachers for their commitment to growing in faith and for striving each day to keep Christ at the center of all they do and say.

INVESTING IN OUR FAITH, STRENGTHENING OUR MISSION

Our SHS teachers are currently in the middle of their third year of Catholic faith formation through the Diocese of Springfield. This ongoing formation is an important part of our commitment to providing our students with an education that is firmly rooted in the Catholic faith. The training is developed through the Evermode Institute and led by the Norbertine Canons at Corpus Christi Priory in Springfield, Illinois. This comprehensive program provides our teachers the opportunity to deepen their knowledge and understanding of the Catholic faith so they can more fully share that faith with their students. Throughout their formation, our teachers study many important aspects of Catholic teaching, including:

- ◆ Theological philosophy and Catholic belief systems
- ◆ The basic tenets of the Catholic faith
- ◆ All aspects of the Sacraments
- ◆ The Nicene Creed
- ◆ The Ten Commandments
- ◆ Sacred Scripture

Their study is supported by Scripture and the teachings contained in the Catechism of the Catholic Church, helping our teachers better understand not only what the Church teaches, but also the biblical and theological foundations of those teachings.



We will celebrate Grandparent's Day on Friday, September 11, which is also Patriot's Day—the anniversary of the September 11, 2001, attacks. In honor of the 25th anniversary of that grave day, all students and grandparents are encouraged to wear red, white and blue Mass attire.

Our Grandparents Day celebration will kick off with a visit to the K-3rd grade classrooms at 12:15pm, followed by a program featuring those K-3 students. The day will conclude with an all-school Mass at 1:30pm in church. All grandparents of students in grades K-8 are welcome at the Mass! Students will be dismissed from Mass with grandparents, or will come back to the school to be dismissed to ride the bus, for parent-pick-up, or for sports practices or games.



Have you noticed our newly painted dugouts yet?! They are amazing! Our Home dugout features a proud "Home of the Shamrocks" message while our Visitor dugout features a special phrase we say at school each day: "Work Hard, Play Hard, Pray Hard".
