

Day 1: Sunday, May 17, 2026 || EFFINGHAM - CHICAGO

Holy Mass at 10:30am at Sacred Heart Church in Effingham. Afterwards, we will enjoy a quick lunch and then board a bus to Chicago. Depart from Chicago's O'Hare Airport at 8:10pm. Late dinner on the plane. Fly overnight to Istanbul.

Day 2: Monday, May 18, 2026 || ARRIVAL TO ISTANBUL

Arrival in Istanbul at 2:50pm. Transfer to the hotel and check-in. After resting, guests may enjoy a short orientation walk in the historic district. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 3: Tuesday, May 19, 2026 || FULL DAY IN ISTANBUL

After breakfast, visit the monumental Hagia Sophia, followed by the underground Basilica Cistern. Next, admire the peaceful and majestic Blue Mosque, and end the day at the Topkapi Palace – the former residence of Ottoman sultans, filled with beautiful buildings and treasures. Dinner and overnight stay in Istanbul. Time to enjoy the vibrant atmosphere of the Grand Bazaar or take a leisurely walk along the Bosphorus.

Day 4: Wednesday, May 20, 2026 | BERGAMA - KUSADASI

Travel north to ancient Pergamon, located above the modern town of Bergama. Continue to Izmir to explore the ruins of Kadifekale ("Velvet Castle") and the ancient agora of Smyrna. Visit the Church of St. Polycarp – one of the Seven Churches of Revelation. Transfer to Kusadasi for dinner and overnight stay. The journey offers scenic views of the Aegean countryside and a glimpse into daily Turkish life.

Day 5: Thursday, May 21, 2026 || KUSADASI


Morning Mass, followed by a stroll through Kusadasi to experience local daily life. *Leisure time on the scenic beaches of the Aegean Sea*. Dinner and overnight stay in Kusadasi. This is a perfect opportunity to unwind, shop for souvenirs, or try local seafood specialties.


Day 6: Friday, May 22, 2026 | EPHESUS - VIRGIN MARY'S HOUSE - SELCUK


Visit Ephesus – one of the largest and most impressive archaeological sites in the world, associated with St. Paul and one of the Seven Churches of Revelation. In the afternoon, visit the Basilica and Tomb of St. John in Selcuk, and the traditional house of the Virgin Mary. Dinner and overnight stay in Kusadasi. Walking through the ancient streets of Ephesus offers a vivid glimpse into the grandeur of Roman civilization.

Day 7: Saturday, May 23, 2026 | IZMIR - PAMUKKALE - LAODICEA

After breakfast, travel to Pamukkale to explore its spectacular white travertine terraces and hot springs. Visit the necropolis in Hierapolis and continue to Laodicea – one of the Seven Churches of Revelation, located on a plateau above the Meander Valley. Dinner and overnight stay in Pamukkale. Capture unforgettable photos of Pamukkale's surreal natural formations and ancient thermal baths.











Day 8: Sunday, May 24, 2026 | PAMUKKALE - KIBYRA - ANTALYA

Drive to Antalya with a stop in the ancient city of Kibyra in Burdur Province – a key trade center in antiquity, situated at the crossroads of Caria, Lydia, Phrygia, and Pisidia. Upon arrival in Antalya, check in to the hotel in the old town district of Kaleici, known for its picturesque streets and Ottoman-era wooden houses. Dinner and overnight stay. Enjoy the serene atmosphere of this coastal gem nestled between mountains and the Mediterranean Sea.

Day 9: Monday, May 25, 2026 | ANTALYA

Morning walking tour through the historic center of Antalya, formerly part of the Roman province of Pamphylia, mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles. *Free time in the afternoon for rest and beach relaxation*. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 10: Tuesday, May 26, 2026 | PERGE

Short drive to Perge – an ancient city connected to a trade route through Side. Though not a port itself, its proximity to the Kestros River made it accessible by water. St. Paul preached here in 46 AD. After the visit, take the afternoon to relax or explore more of Antalya at your own pace. Dinner and overnight stay in Antalya.

Day 11: Wednesday, May 27, 2026 | KONYA - CAPPADOCIA

Breakfast. Travel to Konya – Turkey's most spiritual city and home of the Mevlevi Order (Whirling Dervishes). Known in Roman times as Iconium, it was the capital of the Seljuk Turks and the home of Rumi, the founder of the Sufi order. After visiting Konya, continue to Cappadocia. Dinner and overnight stay. This journey across Anatolia reveals the vast landscapes and rich cultural mosaic of inland.

Day 12: Thursday, May 28, 2026 | CAPPADOCIA

Breakfast. Full-day exploration of the unique landscapes and historical sites of Cappadocia, including Uchisar and the town of Goreme – known for its rock-cut churches, homes, and fairy chimneys shaped by erosion. Visit Kaymakli Underground City, created by early Christians fleeing Arab persecution. Dinner and overnight stay in Cappadocia.


Optional hot-air balloon rides at sunrise offer breathtaking views of the valleys below - about \$400 per person - <u>necessary to book in advance</u>


Day 13: Friday, May 29, 2026 | TARSUS - ADANA


Breakfast. Drive to Tarsus – an ancient city with over 9,000 years of history, located inland from the Mediterranean Sea. Tarsus blends early Christian history with Roman-era architecture in a truly special way. Birthplace of St. Paul and the legendary meeting place of Mark Antony and Cleopatra, Tarsus was once the capital of the Roman province of Cilicia. After visiting St. Paul's site, transfer to Adana. Dinner and overnight stay.

Day 14: Saturday, May 30, 2026 || RETURN FLIGHT

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport. Return flights: Fly from Çukurova at 11:00am, Land in Istanbul at 12:45pm, Fly from Istanbul at 2:45pm, Land in Chicago O'Hare at 6:15pm, Arrive back to Effingham approximately 11:00pm

Itineraries: Itineraries are prepared and scheduled in advance according to the best information available at the time and are subject to change by the date of the pilgrimage.

Pricing: TBP reserves the right to adjust pricing should the following occur; (1) Rise in Airfare due to higher fuel costs, etc. (2) Rise in ground costs due to increases in hotel charges, bus fares, fees, taxes and other costs due to the fluctuating value of the U.S. dollar against foreign currency.

Deposits and final Payments: A deposit of \$1000 per person is required to hold your reservation which is non-refundable. Final payment is due February 28, 2026. Payment can be made by cash or check.

Cancellation fees: If cancellation in writing is received by TBP more than 75 days prior to departure all payments made toward the price of the tour will be refunded, less a \$1000 processing fee. For cancellations received less than 75 days prior to departure, the initial deposit of \$1000 plus any applicable charges imposed by the airlines, hotels, and bus companies on TBP will be non-refundable.
